




EPROS

- Leprosy is a nerve disease caused by a bacteria called Mycobacterium Leprae.
- 95% of the world population is naturally immune to leprosy.
- Leprosy can be fully treated and cured within 6-12 months with Multi Drug Therapy (MDT)
- After the first dose of MDT, a person affected by leprosy becomes completely non-infectious.
- Disability and deformity occur only when leprosy is left undiagnosed. The stigma makes it a lifelong disease.



For centuries, leprosy has caused suffering, stigmatization, discrimination and violation of basic human rights. India accounts for 58% of new leprosy cases worldwide. People affected by leprosy have lost jobs, families, social standing and dignity. This tragic alienation is happening even today when medical care can completely cure a person from the infection.

HEAL India, an initiative by The Leprosy Mission Trust India (TLMTI) is here to eradicate ignorance and the misconceptions surrounding Leprosy. HEAL stands for Hire, Educate, Accept Leprosy. It brings together schools, children, corporates, the youth, the government, NGOs, celebrities and people affected by leprosy.



Since 139 years, The Leprosy Mission has touched over 305 million people across 33 countries through over 200 programmes. In India, we have been actively working on creating a 'Leprosy free India' through our 14 hospitals across the country recognized by the Government of India as Tertiary Leprosy Referral Hospitals, 6 Vocational Training Institutes, a Media Centre, the state-of-the-art Stanley Browne Research Laboratory in New Delhi, and various community-based development projects. TLMTI works in partnership with the Government of India, NLEP, WHO and other international development organizations, for the cause of leprosy. Our various initiatives have played a key role in reducing the stigma attached to the disease and helping people affected by leprosy reintegrate into society.
